## **Latest Trip -**

Nairobi Slum Schools Projects Trust have just returned from their yearly trip to their school in Kenya.

A Very Successful trip with classrooms painted, floors tiled, our electricians put in extra sockets and lights around the outside of our building in anticipation for the school being connected to "Kenya Power Company."

This year 6 people from Jersey and 5 people from Belfast made this exciting and worth while trip. We have 7 classes with 1 head teacher, and 6 teachers/1 cook/1 assistant cook/1 nurse - social worker/ 1 cleaner/3 security watchmen. Our charity also have a feeding programme which funds breakfast and cooked lunch.

We also purchased with the help of a young volunteer "Evan" from Jersey a laptop with a 3 in 1 printer with satellite broadband. We can now contact the school direct through Skype.

Full Uniforms and shoes and all text books and stationary were bought locally by our Charity. A flat screen television and DVD player were installed so educational programmes and a few Disney movies could be watched etc "The Lion King."



We erected and painted a flagpole and our 1st Kenyan flag was bought and a ceremony was held for the children to raise the flag.

## **Future Plans -**

2 extra classrooms, 1 clinic, a surrounding wall plus we have just agreed to have a borehole which alone costs £20,000-00 to ensure the children have fresh drinking water.







## The Christmas Party!

Our Christmas Party was held (yes in February) with 182 children - 92 boys/90 girls, with a Bouncy Castle, clowns, puppet show which these very poor (but happy) deprived children have never seen before.

A guest appearance of Father Christmas and Miss Clause were received with excitement. School bags, toys, drinks, sweets, toothbrushes, and toothpastes were handed out to the noisy excited 182 children.

A young local acrobat squad put on a display with nearly all the local parents watching through our fence.
